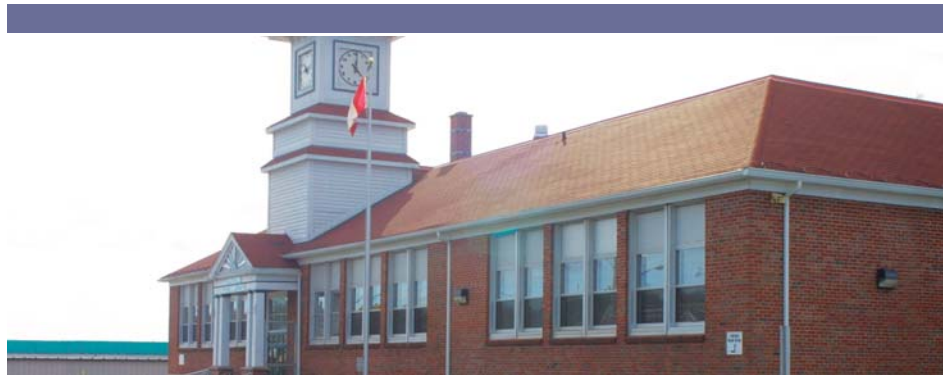


Sackville PUBLIC LIBRARY

FACTS & FIGURES 2008-09

- ▶ 209,211 visitors borrowed 447,037 items; a 4.6% increase in visitors and a slight increase in circulation over 2007-08.
- ▶ This 15,100 sq. ft. library has been located in the former Acadia School since 1996.
- ▶ 11,528 people attended 587 programs offered at Sackville Public Library.
- ▶ 39,620 patrons used Sackville Public Library’s computers and wireless Internet services.
- ▶ Sackville Public Library serves 42,473 residents of HRM. (2006 Census figure)

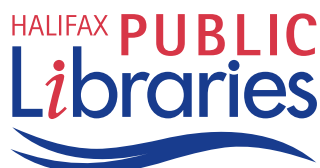
Who has a Library card?

HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Under the auspices of a grant from the Ministry of Justice, Sackville Public Library has developed a model Homework Help service for teens.
- ▶ Sackville Public Library’s facilities include an IT Learning Centre that is available to community groups.
- ▶ Sackville Public Library is a strong partner in the community, engaged in active partnerships with HRM Recreation, Sackville Drive Business Association, Cobequid Community Health Board and the RCMP.
- ▶ Innovative programming for teens at Sackville Public Library includes movie discussions, regular open mic sessions and homework assistance. Many of these programs are funded through community and federal grant monies.
