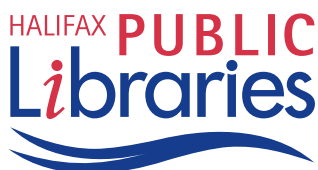


Sheet Harbour PUBLIC LIBRARY

FACTS & FIGURES

- ▶ 26,451 visitors borrowed 40,305 items in 2007-08.
- ▶ This 2,964 sq. ft. library opened in the community in 1981 and has been in its present location since 1992.
- ▶ 1,297 people attended 92 programs offered at Sheet Harbour in 2007-08.
- ▶ 4,656 patrons used Sheet Harbour Public Library's computers and wireless Internet services in 2007-08.
- ▶ Sheet Harbour Public Library serves 3,141 residents of HRM. (2006 Census figure)

Who has a Library card?

27.70% of the population served by the Sheet Harbour Public Library have a library card.



HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Sheet Harbour Public Library was one of two branches to pilot the Leading Readers program (2006-07). Leading Readers pairs elementary school students with high-school student volunteers. The pair reads together, plays educational games, and explores books through fun activities. Sheet Harbour Public Library staff developed expertise in implementing this program and in 2008, helped train other branch staff in best practices. Currently, six branches are running this program.
- ▶ Sheet Harbour Public Library's building has much natural light and large windows. It was recently refurbished with new carpet, modern furniture and comfortable chairs. The branch shares its complex with Job Search Services, HRM Recreation and Access Nova Scotia.
- ▶ With its access to high-speed Internet, Sheet Harbour Public Library is still one of the few public Internet access sites in the area. This is one reason the library enjoys good seasonal use by tourists from the U.S., Europe and Asia.

WHAT THE FUTURE HOLDS

- ▶ In the new year, the Library will accommodate a student from the Co-op Program at Duncan MacMillan High School for 100 hours of work experience. This is a first for Sheet Harbour Library. Although the branch is only open 22 hours weekly, all parties believe that we can make it happen!
- ▶ To build on connections with other community groups and agencies in the area, the Library will be partnering to share knowledge and resources, and to see how we can better serve both the agencies and their individual clients. Group visits to the Library by seniors from local seniors centres and related activities are also being considered.

Sheet Harbour Public Library serves portions of the following HRM District:

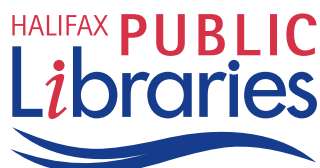
