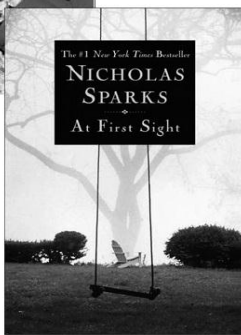
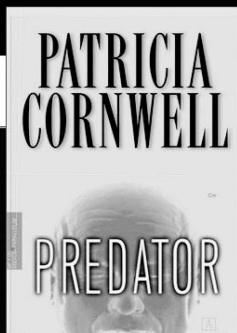
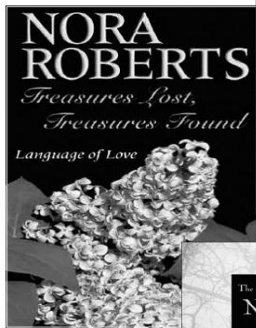

## **What are Large Print books?**

Most Large Print books are printed in this size type (16 point) or larger, on vision-friendly non-glare paper. Today’s Large Print titles have the same bright cover illustrations as regular print editions.

Large Print books are unabridged - you get every word of the original edition. Titles include popular bestsellers, mystery, romance, biography, travel, Canadian fiction, and more.

## **Is borrowing Large Print restricted to certain people?**

No, anyone may borrow Large Print. No special registration is required, but Large Print is especially popular with people with permanent or temporary visual impairment.

Halifax Public Libraries have an extensive collection of Large Print books. These are rotated among the branches regularly, to refresh collections. If a title you want is not in your local branch, you may place a request and it will be sent to your branch. If you need help placing a request, please ask staff to assist you.

## **Other materials and services that may be of interest:**

\*\*\***BOOK CLUB KITS FOR ADULT READERS**: each kit contains eight or more copies of a popular adult book and an information folder consisting of information about the book and author as well as discussion questions. The kit is signed out to a single cardholder for a six week loan period, with no renewals.

**Books on CD**: commercially produced audio books are available to any borrower. Some are full text: others are abridged.

**Descriptive Videos**: these video cassettes play on a regular VCR, but have an added narration which describes the action when no actors are speaking (“The detective is walking down the dark alley. Moonlight glints off something in a doorway...”).

**Home Delivery Services**: for borrowers unable to visit the library in person due to disability, long-term illness, or caregiver responsibilities. Selections are delivered every three weeks by library staff or friendly volunteers. Some branches have waiting lists. Outside the Home Delivery area, Borrow By Mail provides a similar service.

**Accessibility Software**: some branches have public computers equipped with special features to assist those with visual impairments.
