For adults 18+ who are:

- Experiencing OR At-risk of experiencing homelessness
- OR recently housed (up to 6 months).
- Have been in Nova Scotia for over 90 days.
- Legally entitled to remain in Canada.

For clinic eligibility, the HFX ID Project uses the definition of Homelessness as determined by the Canadian Observatory on Homelessness, which means those who are:

1. Unsheltered homeless (living on the streets/in places not intended for human habitation.)
2. Emergency sheltered (staying in shelters).
3. Provisionally accommodated (accommodation is temporary/lacks security of tenure).
4. At-risk of homelessness (not homeless but current economic/housing situation is precarious/does not meet public health and safety standards).
