About the Program

The Estate Clinics assist community members to create their own basic wills, personal directives, and enduring power of attorney at no cost through the use of the Legal Information of Nova Scotia's free online applications. The program allows members of the public to overcome financial and technological barriers that often prevent individuals from having these vital documents.

Sessions will be hosted monthly at the Alderney Gate Public Library.

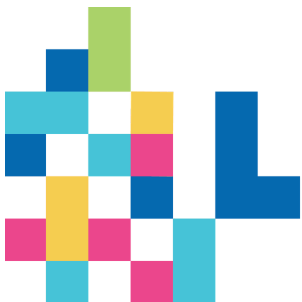
How Volunteers Can Help

As an Estate Navigator Support Volunteer, you will meet 1-on-1 with community members during clinics to assist them with the use of the LISNS applications. You will provide a friendly face, technological support, and legal information to make what can often be a daunting process more approachable.

The Volunteer Role

Under the supervision of Legal Information Society of Nova Scotia staff members, you will:

- Meet by appointment with community members
- Determine if the app is right for the community member and their situation
- Provide basic technological support navigating computer usage
- Answer questions about the applications used to create wills, personal directives, and enduring power of attorneys
- Offer encouragement during the process

We Are Looking for Volunteers Who:

- Are at least 18 years of age.
- Able to speak and read English proficiently, fluency in other languages an asset.
- Are confident using computers, and navigating basic troubleshooting.
- Engage well with others and are skilled at providing personalized help.
- Are friendly, patient, and supportive.
- Understand that it is important to recognize that you are working with individuals from many backgrounds with varying needs.
- Are objective, impartial and non-judgemental in your work.

Time Commitment

Approximately 4 hours a month. Estate Navigation Clinics will be scheduled according to volunteer availability.

All volunteers will require a Criminal Record Check. The Library will initiate the check through MyBackCheck.com and cover the cost.
